

It's not every day we get to celebrate the unveiling of a project seven years in the making!

This winter, the Creston Valley Hospital revealed a new, beautiful, culturally inclusive mural in their main hallway. This project was spearheaded by Dr. Narine Kleinhans and created in collaboration with local indigenous and non-indigenous artists, EKFH, and Creston's ArtsSpace.

The mural brings life, meaning, and a caring welcome to all patients and visitors to the hospital. It is the combined effort of artists Marnie Temple, Allison Masters, Chelsea Luke, James Wallis, Raine Mynott, Renee Phypers and Wendy Tellier. The piece would also not have been possible without Rook Design Media who spent over 40 hours on the printing and installation of the design.

#### **Foundry East Kootenay**

Tikxawi¢ikimik, "for all things to be connected" is now open and providing services for youth across the East Kootenay.

Led by Ktunaxa Kinbasket Child and Family Services, Foundry East Kootenay offers young people 12-24 access to mental health and substance use support, primary care, peer support and social services.

## **Current Campaign**




We are raising \$1.8 million for a Neonatal Intensive Care Unit at East Kootenay Regional Hospital. This will help our newest and youngest lives start off at home in the East Kootenay. The NICU has advanced technology and trained healthcare professionals to give special care for the tiniest patients at the hospital, something currently unavailable in the East Kootenay. The upgrade will keep more premature babies from being airlifted to Kelowna or Vancouver, saving new families from stressful and expensive care.
